ABSTRACT

Stroke is a sudden disorder of brain function caused by a disturbance in the blood circulation of the brain that can happen to anyone and anywhere. Based on the highest percentage of the room, Stroke is the second most common disease of ten diseases in the Public Treatment Room 6 RSPAD Gatot Soebroto Central Jakarta 2018. In this case study used a method with a nursing process approach in 5 patients suffering from stroke infarction in the General Nursing Room 6 RSPAD Gatot Soebroto . 5 infarction stroke patients aged 36-45 years (20%), 46-55 years (20%), and 56-65 years (60%). Sex in male stroke patients (100%). According to the causes found by clients who have diabetes mellitus (40%), hypertension (60%) and who have smoking habit (80%). Nursing studies and diagnoses and nursing actions are tailored to nursing orders and nursing evaluation according to linked theories. Discharge planning conducted health education (100%). In nursing care is found the client's skin condition is less good (40%) because it never changed the position of sleep and not active mobilization. In this case the authors suggest to the family to always keep the patient's skin moisture and suggest to the nurses to do risk assessment of wound press by using Braden scale done every day and evaluated every three days.
