One of the therapies used in the process of cancer cell growth is chemotherapy and one of the effects of chemotherapy is nausea and vomiting. The purpose of this case study is to conduct nursing care in 5 Ca Mammae patients with a nursing process approach. The results of the study were mostly women, over 40 years of age, there is no family history of cancer, Hormonal causes of cancer. Nursing Diagnosis is a change in nutrition less than body need, Chronic pain, High risk of infection, and anxious. Complementary nursing actions with lemon aromatherapy innovations to overcome nausea and vomiting chemotherapy effects. The results of the evaluation of the study showed no effect of lemon aromatherapy to overcome nausea and vomiting in 5 breast cancer patients. Suggestions for patients after being given education can adhere to diet, take regular medication, control poly and can use lemon aromatherapy to cope with nausea and vomiting at home.
