ABSTRACT

Fracture is the breakdown of continuity of bone tissue, which is usually accompanied by wounds around soft tissue, muscle damage, tendon rupture, blood vessel damage, and injuries of the body organs and is determined by type and extent, fracture if bone is subjected to greater stress than can be absorbed. The purpose of this case study is to identify and analyze nursing care in patients with Fracture Extremities in the 5th floor Surgical Room of Gatot Subroto. In this case study used a method of approaching the nursing process with two patients who experienced Fracture Extremities. The two patients are male and female and aged between 71-80 years. According to the cause, all patients found Fractures induced by indirect trauma. The results of the study found two nursing problems with major problems in all patients were impaired physical mobility and pain. After the nursing approach all problems are resolved. The authors suggest that nurses teach patients fracture of the extremities about early ambulation and educate on how to mobilize using aids, for the care of patients at home.
