ABSTRACT

Birth as a natural process in addition to producing normal babies, others have the possibility of children born with congenital / congenital abnormalities. One congenital disorder that can occur in children is hypospadias. Hypospadias is a congenital abnormality in the form of the urethral estuary located on the ventral penis and proximal to the tip of the penis. Hypospadias prevalence is around 4 to 43 cases per 1000 births. This case study aims to determine the Nursing Care of Hypospadias Children with the Effect of Distraction Technique on Watching Ball Videos on Decreasing Scale of Pain in the 1st Floor Room of the Pavilion of Ade Irma Suryani Presidential Hospital Gatot Soebroto Hospital on December 17-26 2019. In writing this case study report the author uses descriptive methods and library methods. Descriptive method: interview technique, observation and physical examination. The primary data sources obtained directly from the child and secondary data obtained from the family, health workers, and other supporting documents. Characteristics of children with hypospadias in 3 children aged toddler (100%) male sex (100%). Surgery is performed: Repair Fistel (66.6%), urotoplasty (33.3). All children undergoing laboratory tests (100%), radiological examination (100%). Changes in the pattern of urinary elimination (100%), acute pain (100%), the risk of infection (100%). All children experience a decrease in the scale of pain and appear relaxed when given non-pharmacological therapy (distraction) by watching video balls when feeling pain (100%).
