The staff does all the work in the medical record unit. The service takes a long time and builds up medical records. And medical records that have not been processed to be many, causing delays in sending reports. Specific Purpose. Calculating the Workload in the Leveling Unit at the Duren Sawit District Health Center in 2019. It is recommended that time standards be set in each activity to be a reference for measuring the time spent in the medical record unit and adding medical recorders in one Duren Sawit puskesmas graduated from the Medical Record
