Title : Overview of the Effects of Change in Record Numbering System Medical Electronics (RME) Against Storage Systems Medical Records at the Jatinegara Health Center

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The numbering system is a numbering system for medical records given to patients when they first seek treatment at a health center, based on the initial survey of the Jatinegara sub-district pukesmas the numbering uses the Unit Numbering system which is implemented using an application that has been determined by the DKI Jakarta Health Office (Simpus, sikda, e pus , e pus ng) integrated. changes in the medical record numbering system affect the medical record storage system and have an impact on medical records that are not found, resulting in ongoing obstruction of medical services and information. The study used a qualitative descriptive cross-sectional method through observation and interview guidelines to informants, medical records officers, information technology (IT) officers, trained admin officers. The results of the study: the storage system policy does not comply with the Standard Operating Procedure (SPO) numbering set in the medical record unit with an average number of medical records that were not found in the last 3 months between October to December 2020 by 30%. Suggestion: run the Medical Record function in accordance with the SPO, provide training guidance and socialization to users of the integrated RME Application.
