

ABSTRACT

Title : Review of Inpatient Medical Record Returns Internal Medicine to the Filing Room at RSUD Jend. Ahmad Yani Kota Metro Propinsi Lampung, 2020

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Study Program: Diploma III Medical Record and Health Information

The development of medical records is an important system in a hospital medical record unit because it is the initial activity before the start of processing a patient's medical record. In accordance with the SOP for restoring medical records at RSUD Jend. Ahmad Yani Kota Metro Propinsi Lampung the length of time to return inpatient medical records is 2x24 hours after the patient goes home. The timeliness of returning medical records of inpatients to internal medicine greatly affects the quality of services at the hospital. The purpose of this study was to determine the return of inpatient medical records in RSUD Jend. Ahmad Yani Kota Metro Propinsi Lampung.

Based on the research results, it is known that from 90 samples of medical records taken from September to December 2020, there were 60 medical records that were returned on time (66.67%) while 30 medical records were returned late (33.33%). The implementation of returning medical records for internal medicine inpatient care that is carried out is not in accordance with the existing SOP and the incompleteness of filling in inpatient medical records for internal medicine is the cause of the delay in returning the medical records of internal medicine inpatients at RSUD Jend. Ahmad Yani Kota Metro Propinsi Lampung

Researchers provide suggestions for re-socialization to related units about the SOP for returning inpatient medical records, improving communication and coordination with other health workers in internal medicine inpatient rooms.
