

ABSTRACT

Title : Review of Accuracy in Encoding Outpatients' Diseases at Puskesmas Payung Rejo Kabupaten Lampung Tengah

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Diagnosis is a description of the disease suffered by the patient. Coding means writing the code of the diagnosis written by the doctor. The speed and accuracy of coding of a diagnosis is very dependent on the executor who handles the medical record, namely medical personnel in determining the diagnosis, medical record staff who provide the diagnosis code, and other health workers who are involved in completing the filling of medical records. The diagnosis code is said to be precise and accurate if it is in accordance with what is written in the ICD-10. The absence of a special coding officer to handle the coding process was a factor in the imperfect coding of all outpatient disease coding at Puskesmas Payung Rejo Kabupaten Lampung Tengah. Writing scientific papers was conducted to determine the accuracy of the coding of outpatient diseases at Puskesmas Payung Rejo Kabupaten Lampung Tengah. In this study, 87 samples of medical records at Puskesmas Payung Rejo were taken by looking at the disease code and then the disease code was compared with those in the ICD-10 book.

The results showed that from 87 samples of medical records, 55 disease codes were correct according to the ICD-10 book (63%) and 32 disease codes were incorrect (28%). From the results of the study, it was concluded that the coding of outpatient diseases at Puskesmas Payung Rejo Kabupaten Lampung Tengah was not correct. The purpose of writing scientific papers is that the Puskesmas Payung Rejo Kabupaten Lampung Tengah can be more precise in giving outpatient disease codes according to the ICD-10 book.
