RELATION OF MOTHER KNOWLEDGE, HUSBAND AND PARAMEDIC SUPPORT TO SUCCESSFUL EARLY INITIATION OF BREASTFEEDING (IMD) AT REGIONS OF TANGERANG CITY HOSPITALS

Background: Based on Indonesia Demographic and Health Survey 2007, neonatal mortality rate in Indonesia is 19 deaths / 1000 live births, infant mortality rate is 34/1000 births, and mortality rate is 44/1000 live births. Early Breastfeeding Initiation (IMD) provides benefits for the baby's survival, because breastfeeding can improve child survival, improve health status, especially improve brain and motor development.

Objective: To find out whether there the relation of mother knowledge, husband and paramedic support to successful initiation of early breastfeeding (IMD) at regions of Tangerang City Hospitals.

Method: This research is a quantitative research using cross sectional study design with accidental sampling technique, then analyzed by using chi-square test. This study uses G-Power software with samples obtained as much as 52 to be sampled.

Result: There is a correlation between mother knowledge with IMD success ($p < 0,05$). There is a relationship between support of paramedic and the success of IMD ($p < 0.05$).

Conclusion: The more information for the mother can get the better the mother's knowledge of IMD. The more husbands pay attention and love the mother the better the mother's response to do the IMD. The better and friendliness of aparamedics to the maternal mother the better the mother's response to the IMD.
