ABSTRACT

Death does not choose age, the children did not escape death. Cancer is still the second leading cause of death in children under 15 years (after accident) in the United States recorded 1340 children died from cancer in 2012 (American Cancer Society, 2015). This study aims to identify the effect of psychosocial support education on family readiness in dealing with child mortality with cancer at Gatot Subroto Hospital Central Jakarta 2017. The method used is Non-Experimental with one group pre-test and post-test design. The samples used were families with children who had cancer in RSPAD Gatot Soebroto as many as 15 respondents and sampling using total sampling. Result of research by using test of hypothesis Wilcox on at level of significance $\alpha = 0.05$ indicate that value of ρ -value = 0.002. The value of ρ -value < α , that is 0.002 <0.05, means that there is influence of family psychosocial support to the readiness to face death of child with cancer. It Expected family would apply psychosocial support in children who have cancer and can be ready to deal with child mortality.
