## ABSTRACT

Medical records must be made by the hospital and filled in completely and clearly in writing and electronically. The initial inpatient medical assessment form is part of the contents of the medical record. In Tarakan Hospital, Jakarta, filling in the inpatient initial medical review form is still incomplete so the use value is less than optimal. The data analyzed is the initial inpatient medical assessment form in June 2018. The purpose of this study was to identify the SPO filling in the initial inpatient medical assessment, calculating the percentage of completeness in filling out the initial inpatient medical assessment form and identifying the factors causing incompleteness in filling out the initial inpatient medical review form. Ouantitative analysis is to look at the entire contents of the medical record to identify deficiencies. The research was conducted using descriptive research methods, using proportion estimation formulas, and sampling using systematic random sampling. Based on the results of 83 researches on inpatient medical assessment were obtained on average. Average completeness of 74%. The SPO filling in the initial assessment of hospitalization already exists. The contributing factor to the incompleteness of filling in inpatient preliminary medical assessment forms was the lack of compliance by the patient responsible physician so that the form was written incompletely and was not filled because there were many outpatients who had to be treated and inpatients who had to be visited. For this reason, it is suggested that revising the SPO, including psychological, social, economic assessments (work, social, economic, psychiatric and habits history) into the completeness of the important criteria, there must be a policy of not practicing more than 3 hospitals, limiting the number of outpatients and sanctioning for doctors who often complete incomplete inpatient medical assessment forms.
