Title : Review Competency of Medical Recorder and Health Information at the Kembangan District Health Center.

The Community Health Center (Puskesmas) is one of the most important public health service facilities in Indonesia. The Health Center is the first guardian of health services for the entire community. RI Minister of Health Regulation No. 75 of 2014 concerning Puskesmas in Article 1 describes the District / City Health Office that is responsible for organizing matters in health development in the district / city. In this case to optimize the function of the puskesmas, the management of the puskesmas is carried out in an integrated and sustainable manner. For this reason, it is necessary to have effective and efficient performance, especially in collecting data on the results of the implementation of activities, up to the processing and utilization. For Medical Recorders and Health Information (PMIK), we have learned in the lecture that the medical record system is not only in one room, which is commonly called a Medical Record room that deals with the preparation and storage of medical record files but includes data collection to produce information. . The collection of patient data that has been carried out by health workers at the sub-district level Puskesmas in the DKI Jakarta area has been integrated with the Regional Health Information System (SIKDA) designed to be the standard for the DKI Jakarta Government in managing health information. Data management as health information is the work of a PMIK. According to Permenkes No. 55 of 2013, PMIK is a person who has graduated from Medical Record and Health Information education. As a graduate of PMIK, you must master 7 basic competency standards, with the development of patient data collection systems at sub-district level health centers that have turned into SIKDA, from 7 PMIK competencies according to KMK No.377 / Menkes / SK / III / 2007 there are several PMIK competencies that have not implemented in accordance with PMIK competency standards in the PKC Kembangan.
