

## ABSTRACT

Title : Relationship between Mother's Level of Education, Knowledge and Job Levels by Providing Complementary Foods at Posyandu RW. 32 Sub District of Teluk Pucung in 2018

Complementary feeding are foods or drinks that contain nutrients given to babies or children to fulfill their nutritional needs. Provision of improper complementary breastfeeding can cause many losses. This study uses a cross sectional approach with sampling using simple random sampling. The population were all mothers who came to RW 32 Posyandu with a total sample of 55 mothers. The results showed that of the 55 respondents most of the mothers had a higher education level of 38 mothers (69.1%), 28 mothers (51%) had high knowledge, 30 mothers (54.5%) did not work and 35 mothers ( 63.6%) right in providing complementary food for breast milk. Statistical tests using Chi square showed that there was a relationship between the level of education, knowledge and work of mothers with breastfeeding complementary foods ( $p < 0.05$ ). An approach and refresher need to be done so that the mother's knowledge remains good in the implementation of complementary feeding.
