: Related Factors to Malnutrition Status in Toddlers (0-59 months)

at Babakan Asem Village Tangerang District in 2018

Nutritional problems of toddler faced by Indonesia nowadays is the malnutrition which is the main cause of morbidity and mortality. Malnutrition is a condition in which a toddler experiences a lack of relative and absolute food consumption over a period of time. Result of Riskesdas from 82,661 toddlers in Indonesia, the prevalence of malnutrition toddler in 2013 is 13,9%. According to WHO, public health issues are taken seriously if the malnutrition prevalence is between 20.0-29,0%. The general purpose of this research is to analyze the risk factors related with incidence malnutrition of toddler at Babakan Asem Village Tangerang District in 2018. This research used quantitative approach with case control design. Sampling is done with total sampling technique for case groups and sistematik random sampling for control groups. The results of Chi-Square and Fisher Exact's test stated that there was a significant relationship between food intake (OR = 8,125; CI = 2,219-29,748), the mother's level of education (OR = 1,25) 9,143 ; CI = 2,259-37,010), family income (OR = 5,385 ; CI = 1,587-18,264) to incidence of malnutrition in toddler (0-59 months) at Babakan Asem Village, Tangerang District. Whereas there was no significant relationship between exclusive breastfeeding and history of infectious diseases. It is recommended to forming a food consumption survey team by Puskesmas Teluknaga, team by Puskesmas Teluknaga can collaborate across sectors with schools in improving the Youth Care Health Service (PKPR) program and also hope that the officials of Tangerang district region, especially in the Babakan Asem Village, can provide easy access to distant schools that can be overcome by providing public transportation routes that enter the village, expanding the employment in Babakan Asem Village area and Future researchers are expected to be able to make interview questions that are able to make respondents remember related foods consumed by toddlers in the last 2 days when collecting data.
