Title : Relationship between Completeness of Nursing Information, Resume and Supporting Examination with the Accuracy of the Diagnosis code in Inpatient Documents at Sumber Waras Hospital in 2018.

The accuracy of the diagnosis code is the accuracy of giving a diagnosis code based on ICD-10 by a coding officer. Determining the accuracy of the diagnosis code is done by matching the results of the coding with the rules or rules according to WHO procedures that exist on the ICD-10. Many factors that affect the accuracy of diagnostic codes include the completeness of medical information, resumes, and investigations. The purpose of this study is to find out the relationship between Completeness of Nursing Information, Resume and Supportive Examination with the Accuracy of the Diagnosis code in Inpatient Documents at the Sumber Waras Hospital in 2018. This research was conducted observational using a quantitative approach with cross sectional design. The total sample of this study is 80 medical record documents. The sampling technique used was systematic random sampling. Data collection was carried out in the Medical Record Service of Sumber Waras Hospital in September-December 2018. The analysis technique used was Chi Square with $\alpha = 5\%$. The research instrument used was a checklist sheet on medical record documents. The results showed that all the variables studied showed a relationship, namely completeness of medical information ($p = 0,000$), completeness of the resume ($p = 0,000$), and completeness of the examination ($p = 0.006$).
