## **ABSTRACT**

Hospitals are required to record and report on all hospital management activities in the form of hospital management information systems. One form of hospital external reporting is reporting on outpatient morbidity data. This report will later be used as an external report needed by the Health Office. The purpose of this study was to find out the complete data on the causes of injury in the medical record of cases of traffic accident patients for the preparation of RL4B reports. The research method in the study was descriptive with a total of 95 medical records. The technique of collecting data is by observation, interview, and literature study. With the results of 42 medical records (44.21%) written the causes of external injuries, 53 medical records (55.78%) were not written causes of outside injury. While from 42 written medical records the causes of injuries were 26 medical records (61.9%) complete in writing out causes of injury, 16 medical records (38.09%) incomplete writing outside causes of injury. The implementation of data collection has been carried out with procedures, but many have not been filled due to inconsistencies in the causes of outside injuries. Factors causing incomplete data on the causes of traffic accidents are that doctors do not write out the causes of injury, coders who do not code outside causes, because there is no procedure, it is recommended to the hospital to do SPO socialization on how to implement complete traffic accident coding. and right between coding officers and doctors.
