Occupational Safety and Health (K3) is an effort to develop cooperation, mutual understanding, and effective participation of employers or administrators and workers in workplaces to carry out joint duties and obligations in the field of safety and occupational health in the framework of launching production efforts. From the observations made by the researchers, it was found that 145 warehouse workers, SPG / SPB and cleaning service experienced work accidents in 2017, of whom 33 people slipped due to the condition of the floor and scattered rubbish, where 49 people were stricken with stored items at the top of this because the rack is too high, 64 people fall when pulling things not by using tools or stairs that have been provided by PT. Arina Multi Karya conditions are limited warehouse space and high shelf placement of goods so that it causes a dense storage area of goods that are located in the dirak and the limited number of stairs and slippery floor conditions. The purpose of this study was to determine the description of the implementation of occupational safety and health (K3) workers at PT. Arina Multi Karya Year 2018. This type of research is quantitative descriptive analytical method with cross sectional approach with 70 respondents as respondents and uses random sampling method. Based on the results of the study that of the four variables were not normally distributed.
