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Title : Factors Related to Patient Safety Incident by Nurses in Inpatients at Tangerang Regency General Hospital in 2019

ABSTRACT

The number of patient safety incidents in the inpatient installation of X Hospital in Tangerang Regency during 2017, from 2018 to 2019 increased from 38 cases in 2017, 42 cases in 2018 to 106 cases in 2019 including cases of unexpected events, events No Injury, Nearly Injury Event, Potential Injury Event. Likewise, nurses who did patient safety incidents in inpatient installations increased from 2017 by 1.66%, in 2018 by 3.64%, to 26.8% in 2019. Knowing the factors related to safety incidents patients by nurses in the inpatient installation X Hospital Tangerang Regency in 2019. This research was conducted in January 2020 using quantitative methods with cross sectional design. In this study used a simple random sampling technique, with a total sample of 81 respondents. Data analysis was performed univariately and bivariately with chi-square test ($\alpha =$ (0.05) and calculating the value of the Prevalence Ratio (PR). From the results of this study it was found that the factors associated with patient safety incidents were adherence to SOP (p-value = 0.017; PR = 1,600). The conclusion from the results of this study is that adherence to SOP is related to patient safety incidents. Suggestion for Hospital X Tangerang Regency is expected that the applicable Standard Operating Procedures be carried out systematically in full by all nurses.
