

ABSTRACT

Title : Factors related to mother seeking behavior treatment for pneumonia in children under five years at the North Jakarta Koja Puskesmas in 2019

Based on the annual report of Health Office in 2018, Koja Community Health Center was the highest incidence of pneumonia from six community health center in North Jakarta. The objective of this study was to analyse the factors related to the behavior of mothers in the search for treatment of pneumonia in the Koja Community Health Center North Jakarta in 2019. The study used cross sectional, with samples amounting to 75 mothers who have pneumonia children under five years. Data was analysed with univariate and bivariate (Chi Square test). The study was conducted in September-January 2020. There was a relationship between knowledge (PR = 1.962, 95% CI: 1,126-3,417), perception of seriousness of the pneumonia (PR = 1,965, 95% CI: 1,177-3,281), trust (PR = 2.000, 95% CI: 1,206-3,317), health service access (PR = 3.188 CI 95% (1,846-5,503) with mother seeking behavior treatment for pneumonia in children under five years. Health officers were expected to give information about definition pneumonia, impact, treatment and prevention pneumonia so mother has good knowledge and perceived seriousness of pneumonia good so mother seeking behavior for treatment pneumonia is good and children under five years immediately brought to health services for medication.
