Penelitian ini membahas Analisis Penyebab Ketidaklengkapan Pengisian Formulir Persetujuan Tindakan Kedokteran (*Informed Consent*) Pasien Rawat Inap di Ruang Flamboyan Rumah Sakit Anna Medika Tahun 2020. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui gambaran tentang penyebab ketidaklengkapan pengisian formulir *informed consent*. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif dengan teknik pengumpulan data melalui wawancara mendalam, telaah dokumen dan observasi. Pada penelitian ini terdapat tiga variabel, yaitu pengetahuan, kebijakan organisasi rumah sakit terkait *informed consent*, dan peran perawat. Berdasarkan hasil wawancara mendalam, keempat informan sudah memahami sepenuhnya apa itu pengertian, tujuan, manfaat dari *informed consent*, dan penyebab ketidaklengkapan pengisian *informed consent* di RS Anna Medika dikarenakan beberapa faktor seperti banyaknya pasien yang berkunjung, dokter sibuk, waktu terlalu padat, dan dokter ingin cepat pulang dikarenakan ada praktek di rumah sakit lain sehingga lupa melengkapi pengisian formulir *informed consent* dan akhirnya terlewat untuk dilengkapi. Pada telaah dokumen dan observasi tidak adanya SPO tentang kelengkapan berkas *informed consent*, SPO evaluasi kelengkapan *informed consent*, dan SPO kelengkapan identitas pasien rawat inap, sehingga tidak adanya acuan atau pedoman yang membahas bentuk standar pengisian formulir *informed consent*. Peran perawat sangat penting dalam membantu dan mengingatkan DPJP (Dokter Penanggungjawab Pasien) pada saat mendampingi. Saran peneliti sebaiknya diadakan sosialisasi setiap bulannya terkait pengisian *informed consent*, monitoring, evaluasi, sanksi dan *reward* bagi DPJP atau tenaga medis lainnya atas kelengkapan berkas rekam medis khususnya *informed consent*.

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## ABSTRACT

**Title** : *Analysis of Causes for Completeness in Completion of Informed Consent Forms for Inpatients in the Flamboyant Room of Anna Medika Hospital in 2020.*

*This study discusses the analysis of the causes of incompleteness in filling informed consent forms for inpatients in the Flamboyant Room of Anna Medika Hospital in 2020. The purpose of this study was to find a picture of the causes of incompleteness in filling informed consent forms. This research is a qualitative research with data collection techniques through in-depth interviews, document review and observation. In this study there are three variables, namely knowledge, hospital organization policies related to informed consent, and the role of nurses. Based on the results of in-depth interviews, the four informants fully understood what understanding, purpose, the benefits of informed consent, and the causes of incompleteness of filling informed consent at Anna Medika Hospital were due to several factors such as the large number of patients visiting, doctors busy, time was too crowded, and doctors wanted rushed home because there was practice at another hospital and had forgotten to complete filling out the informed consent form and finally missed it for completion. In the document review and observation of the absence of SPO regarding the completeness of the informed consent file, the SPO evaluates the completeness of the informed consent, and the SPO completeness of the identity of the inpatient, so there is no reference or guidance that discusses the standard form of filling the informed consent form. The role of the nurse is very important in helping and reminding DPJP (Doctor in charge of the Patient) when accompanying her. Researcher suggestions should be conducted monthly socialization related to the filling of informed consent, monitoring, evaluation, sanctions and rewards for DPJP or other medical personnel for the completeness of medical record files, especially informed consent.*
