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**Relationship between Knowledge and Driving Safety Behavior in Student of  
1st Waringinkurung Senior High School in 2020**

**ABSTRAK**

The advancement of science and technology has made the growth rate of vehicles increasingly bring a positive impact on the welfare of human life and the negative impact on the highway. Based on a preliminary survey conducted on 30 students by filling out a questionnaire regarding knowledge of riding behavior, 19 students have low knowledge and 11 students have good knowledge of riding behavior. Factors that influence safety riding include knowledge, behavior, perceptions, ownership of SIMs and the support of others. To find out the Relationship between Knowledge and Behavior of Safety Riding in Student of 1st Waringinkurung Senior High School in 2020. The research method used was quantitative with cross-sectional research techniques. Research variables were analyzed using the Chi-square test. Bivariate analysis revealed a relationship between knowledge and safety riding. Working closely with the police to provide socialization, add regulations to and from the school.

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
