World Health Organization (WHO) menyatakan keselamatan pasien merupakan masalah kesehatan masyarakat global yang serius. Kesalahan medis dapat disebabkan oleh faktor sistem dan faktor manusia. Insiden Keselamatan Pasien yang merugikan adalah terkait dengan prosedur bedah (27%), kesalahan pengobatan (18,3%) dan kesehatan infeksi terkait perawatan (12,2%). Laporan insiden keselamatan pasien di Indonesia oleh Komite Keselamatan Pasien Rumah Sakit Indonesia berdasarkan provinsi pada kuartal 1 periode Januari-April 2010 ditemukan provinsi Jawa Barat menempati urutan tertinggi sebesar 33,33% diantara provinsi lainnya seperti Banten 20,0%, Jawa Tengah 20,0%, DKI Jakarta 16,67%, Bali 6,67%, Jawa Timur 3,37%. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui faktor-faktor yang mempengaruhi perilaku perawat dalam penerapan patient safety Di Ruang Perawatan Rumah Sakit “X” Bekasi Tahun 2020. Penelitian menggunakan desain *cross sectional*, dengan sample sebesar 36 perawat. Teknik pengambilan sample menggunakan metode total sampling dengan analisis data univariat dan bivariat. Penelitian dilakukan bulan Mei-September 2020. Hasil univariat dengan proporsi seimbang yaitu pada perilaku perawat baik dan kurang baik sebanyak 18 perawat (50%) yang lebih dominan mempengaruhi adalah usia perawat 41-65 tahun sebanyak 14 perawat (87,5%), tingkat pendidikan vokasional sebanyak 15 perawat (65,2%) dan masa kerja baru sebanyak 18 perawat (78,3%) dalam penerapan budaya patient safety. Hasil bivariat terdapat hubungan antara usia, tingkat pendidikan, masa kerja dan tidak adanya hubungan antara jenis kelamin dan sikap terhadap perilaku penerapan budaya *patient safety* Diruang Perawatan Rumah Sakit “X” Bekasi Tahun 2020.

The World Health Organization (WHO) states patient safety is a serious global public health problem. Medical errors can be caused by system factors and human factors. The incidence of adverse patient safety was associated with surgical procedures (27%), medication errors (18.3%) and health care-related infections (12.2%). Report of patient safety incidents in Indonesia by the Indonesian Hospital Patient Safety Committee by province in the first quarter of the January-April 2010 period found West Java province ranked the highest at 33.33% among other provinces such as Banten 20.0%, Central Java 20.0 %, DKI Jakarta 16.67%, Bali 6.67%, East Java 3.37%. The purpose of this study was to determine the factors that influence the behavior of nurses in the application of patient safety in the Hospital Care Room "X" Bekasi in 2020. This study used a cross sectional design, with a sample of 36 nurses. The sampling technique used total sampling method with univariate and bivariate data analysis. The research was conducted in May-September 2020. Univariate results with a balanced proportion, namely 18 nurses' good and bad behavior (50%), the more dominant influence was the age of 41-65 years old as many as 14 nurses (87.5%). 15 nurses (65.2%) with vocational education and 18 nurses (78.3%) new tenure in implementing a patient safety culture. The bivariate results showed a relationship between age, education level, years of service and there was no relationship between gender and attitudes towards the behavior of implementing the culture of patient safety in the Hospital Care Room "X" Bekasi in 2020.
