## **ABSTRACT**

Appendicitis (dead ends in the tip of the cecum) is a condition that most often requires surgery at the age of children. Although rare in children under 2 years of age, appendicitis (appendicitis) is often accompanied by complications and mortality with an increased incidence. This inflammation is a significant pediartic problem because the diagnosis is often too late to be enforced and often children are unable to express symptoms with words, besides that clinical signs can be confused with other diseases. Postoperative (postoperative) patients experience severe pain and 75% of patients have unpleasant experiences due to inadequate pain. If patients complain of pain, non-pharmacological techniques are needed to reduce pain.
