## **ABSTRACT**

Based on the Decree of the Minister of Health of the Republic of Indonesia No. 129/MENKES/SK/II/2008 concerning Minimum Service Standards for Hospitals, that the completeness of filling out the informed consent after obtaining clear information is 100%. The purpose of the study was to determine the percentage of completeness of approval for surgical cases at RSAL Dr. Mintohardjo, Central Jakarta. The research method uses a descriptive method with a quantitative approach. With a sample of 90 medical records of surgical patients in April 2021. The conclusions from this study are still not 100% complete according to the Ministry of Health's Minimum Service Standards No. 129 in 2008, the average percentage of completeness was 69.67% (63 RM) and the percentage of incompleteness was 30.33% (37 RM). The highest completeness results were obtained from component I related to Patient Identification, and the highest incompleteness results were obtained from Component IV related to Good Recording. The cause of the incompleteness is due to DPJP's negligence not filling in the blank information with a (-), DPJP's negligence because it did not re-complete the incomplete information in writing for documentation after the patient had finished receiving health services, differences in the surgical procedures to be performed on the patient. Suggestions to the RM committee to re-socialize service providers, especially surgeons, to make corrections in writing according to the provisions, pay attention to filling out the approval sheet for medical surgical cases before the procedure or after the patient has finished receiving health services.
