Title : Critical Discourse Analysis in Reporting the Omnibus Law Demo Action 8 October 2020 on Detik.com and Republika.co.id News Portals

Since the ratification of the RUU Omnibus Law through the plenary session of the DPR on October 5, 2020, there have been protests from various circles of society. Students, workers, and civil society alliances held demonstrations in several regions in Indonesia to reject the ratification of the Omnibus Law. The rapid flow of information dissemination can be felt during the demonstration against the Omnibus Law in October 2020 at Detik.com and Republika.co.id. This study aims to analyze the Critical Discourse theory in reporting the demonstration against the Omnibus Law on October 8, 2020 on the news portals Detik.com and Republika.co.id and to explain the selection process for news portals Detik.com and Republika.co.id. In this study, the theory that the author uses is the theory of discourse analysis of Teun A van Dijk by analyzing the elements of text structure analysis, analysis of social cognition, and analysis of social context. Meanwhile, this study approach uses a qualitative method with a critical paradigm. In this study, the researchers also interviewed Detik.com and Republika.co.id to add to the data, namely interviewing the Managing Editor of Detik.com and the Managing Editor of Republika.co.id. The results of this study indicate that in the analysis of text structure, social cognition, and social context, there are differences in discourse such as the direction of reporting on the text dimension and differences in journalists' cognition schemes on the dimension of social cognition in the news raised by Detik.com and Republika.co.id. There were also differences in the news selection process between Detik.com and Republika.co.id.
