**ABSTRACT**

**Background :** Spirituality is an aspect of human personality which gives the power and influence of individuals in living his life . Spirituality is the essence of who and how people live in the world . Spirituality is very important for human existence . The fulfillment of the spiritual care of patients related to levels of spirituality nurse . There are several factors that influence the behavior of nurses in providing spiritual care . The understanding of spirituality alone can empower ourselves in providing the care of the spiritual needs of patients at Atma Jaya Hospital .

**Objective :** This study aimed to determine the relationship of spirituality and spiritual care of patients in the inpatient unit Atma Jaya Hospital .

**Methods:** The study was a quantitative cross-sectional design of the 71 respondents were selected with a total sampling technique .Univariate analysis of the data using frequency distribution and bivariate analyzes using Kendall 's Tau test .

**Results :** Univariate results obtained highest spiritual upbringing patients ( 69.0 % ) , spirituality Nurse highest ( 97.2 % ) , nurses spirituality relationship with God the highest ( 97.2 % ) , relationship with oneself ( 97.2 % ) , relationships with others ( 91.5 % ) and relationship with religion ( 83.1 % ) and the results of the bivariate spirituality spiritual care nurses and patients in the inpatient unit Atma Jaya Hospital (  $p = 0.153 : p > 0.05$  )

**Conclusion :** There is no significant relationship between spirituality nurses and spiritual care of patients at Atma Jaya Hospital .
