Judul : Tinjauan Kebutuhan Tenaga Perekam Medis Dan Informasi Kesehatan Di Puskesmas Leuwiliang Menggunakan Abk Kes

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Program Studi : Rekam Medis dan Informasi Kesehatan

Puskesmas Leuwiliang, Bogor Jawa Barat yang merupakan puskesmas tipe Utama Rawat Jalan dimana unit rekam medis khususnya hanya memiliki 1 tenaga kerja. Rekam Medis dan 2 Tenaga Pendaftaran di Puskesmas berfungsi untuk Melakukan Pendaftaran pasien , pengambilan , distribusi , coding dan penyimpanan rekam medis . Diketahui kegiatan Rekam Medis dilakukan oleh 1 petugas dengan jumlah rekam medis 61.068 pasien rawat jalan pada tahun 2021. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mendapatkan gambaran jumlah kebutuhan tenaga rekam medis yang sesuai dengan beban kerja di Puskesmas Leuwiliang. Penelitian ini bersifat deskriptif kuantitatif, yaitu melakukan penelitian secara langsung untuk mengetahui jumlah kebutuhan tenaga rekam medis berdasarkan data dari wawancara dan observasi. Berdasarkan hasil perhitungan Analisis Beban Kerja Kesehatan (ABK Kes) diketahui Standar Beban Kerja (SBK) 5,9 rekam medis/tahun dibagi capaian 1 tahun 61.068 pasien rawat jalan lalu dibagi lagi dengan Standar Tugas Penunjang (STP) didapatkan jumlah tenaga rekam medis yang dibutuhkan sebanyak 8 orang.

ABSTRACT

Title : Review of the Needs of Medical Recorders and Health Information At The Leuwiliang Health Center Using Abk Kes

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Study Program : Medical Records and Health Information

Puskesmas Leuwiliang, Bogor, West Java, which is an outpatient main type health center where the medical record unit in particular only has 1 workforce. Medical Records and 2 Registration Personnel at puskesmas serve to carry out patient registration, retrieval, distribution, coding and storage of medical records. It is known that the Medical Record activity was carried out by 1 officer with a total of 61,068 outpatient medical records in 2021. This study aims to get an overview of the number of medical record personnel needs that are in accordance with the workload at the Leuwiliang Health Center. This research is descriptive quantitative, namely conducting research directly to determine the number of needs of medical record personnel based on data from interviews and observations. Based on the calculation results of the Health Workload Analysis (ABK Kes), it is known that the Workload Standard (SBK) of 5.9 medical records / year divided by the achievement of 1 year 61,068 outpatients and then subdivided by the Supporting Task Standards (STP) obtained the number of medical record personnel needed as many as 8 people.
