ABSTRACT

Background : A family’s support is a family’s attitude, action and receptivity toward a patient. To have the endoscopy procedures requires the patient’s motivation. The patient’s motivation is very influenced by how good is the family’s supports given to a patient to have the endoscopy procedures.

Objectives : This research is aim to analyze the influences of families’ supports toward the patient’s motivation to have an endoscopy procedures in endoscopy unit of RSUD Cengkareng and RSUD Tarakan.

Research Methodology : This is a quantitative research by using across – sectional approach. The population on this research were patients who have been taking endoscopy procedures on both visit or stay medical treatment in 2014.

The way of taking sample is purposive sampling of 34 respondents. The data analysis for univariate by using frequency distribution , bivariate that used Chi-Square.

Research Findings : Characteristic of respondents mean age was 39,8 years, most were men, most of the respondents were supported by their families (80,4%) and most of them were motivated (67,6%). Statistical test result indicates that there is a positive influence of families’ informational and rewarding supports toward a patient’s motivation to have the endoscopy procedures ($p < 0,05$).

Conclusion : The more a family’s supports to a patient, the higher he/she get motivation to have a procedure of Endoscopy.
