ABSTRACT

Ideally students are role models for the community in general but now the student has become a source of conflict, in the form of arrogance, and a disturbing brawl citizens. Social maturity to be one of the factors that influence aggressive behavior.

This study is a quantitative non-experimental korelational, with sample amounts to 164 students at the University of Esa Unggul active Excellence 2013/2014 odd. Measuring devices such as emotional maturity questionnaire (35 items valid) and aggressive behavior (37 items valid) with the respective reliability of (α) of 0.945 and a (α) 0.947.

The results showed that there was a negative and significant relationship between emotional maturity and aggressive behavior in University of Esa Unggul students (sig. (P) = 0.01, (r) = -0.004). The higher the emotional maturity of students, the lower the aggression behavior. University of Esa Unggul students who have aggressive behavior tends to be much lower than the high aggressive behavior. While that aspect of emotional maturity that has influence with aggressive behavior is an aspect of objective thinking (p = 0.000), aspects have a sense of responsibility (p = 0.000).
