Nun is a job for Catholic women who's willing to not get married and life simple. Some nuns have an assignments to become a teacher in the special school. Life to serve the children with special needs with patience and have a limitation from the outside of monastery makes a job as a nun looks not happy. The purpose of this research is to get subjective well-being description of the nun who's teaching in the special school.

This research used qualitative methods. Three subjects of this research are nuns who's teaching in the special school. Subjects were selected by purposive sampling methods. Datas in this research obtained with in-depth-interview and non participant observation. Interview results processed into verbatim, coding, and then into comparative analysis.

The result of this research is three subjects have not reach subjective well-being yet. On the first subject, she has uncomfortable relationship with peoples around her. On the second subject, she has envyness to peoples who's working not as a nun. Third subject feels working as a nun is an exhausting job.
