In nursing care have discovered a new discovery in the case study is to do early mobilization as a measure to cope with the fall sense of shortness of breath experienced by clients especially in fulfilling the breathing patterns of clients, and to overcome the rigidity of vulnerable motion experienced by clients that particularly in the fulfillment of barriers to physical mobility client Post Op Kraniotomy. In this case the researchers suggested for health care establishments (hospitals) in doing this early mobilization needed a comfortable space in its application.
