SUMMARY

Liver cirrhosis is the final stage of liver disease until now there is no therapy that provides effective results, cirrhosis ranks seventh leading cause of death. Based on the highest percentage in the room, hepatic cirrhosis is 10 clinical cases. Unidentified nursing care to clients with hepatic cirrhosis disease in the General Care Floor Space 6 RS RS Presidential Gatot Subroto Army Hospital in Central Jakarta, 2016. The purpose of the study to identify nursing care to clients with liver cirrhosis. This report uses the case study method with the approach of the nursing process with 5 clients hepatic cirrhosis in the General Care Floor Space 6 RS Presidency Gatot Subroto Army Hospital. All clients (100%) had a high school education, Islamic religion and gender to male. According to the causes were found entirely (100%) 5 client hepatitis. A total of 5 clients (100%) no urinary complaints such as concentrated tea water, nausea, vomiting and anorexia, dry skin, scaly and pale, edema, weakness, restlessness, yellow skin (jaundice). Assessment and nursing diagnoses and nursing actions tailored to the appropriate nursing interventions and evaluation of the theory associated with the client's condition. In the case study authors conducted Award olive oil as a way to overcome the dryness experienced by clients transform and overcome interference with the client's skin integrity hepatic cirrhosis. Of the five clients who experienced improvement in dry skin was 4 (80%) of clients and 1 (20%) clients experienced a drought so severe that require more than 3 days to give the olive oil in this case the authors suggest for instance health services (hospitals) in the conduct giving miyak olive skin in the morning, afternoon and evening.
