Title : The Related Knowledge Of Health and Safety With Unsafe Behavior to

Nurse In the Inpatient Unit at RSKD Duren Sawit, East Jakarta

Background: Hospital is one of the companies whose work contains great potential danger, such as infection, fire, pollution, and other hazard potentials. With the tremendous danger of accidents that can happen it is necessary to know whether the implementation of occupational health in accordance with the standards set. Human factors or human factor is one of the factors that most influence on the occurrence of the accident in the hospital. The impact caused the unsafe behavior is the occurrence of occupational accidents and occupational diseases that lead to losses for both companies and workers. Knowledge of Health and Safety at Work influence on Unsafe Behavior in the works.

Objective: To Know the relationship of knowledge about health and safety at work with unsafe behavior in nurses in the inpatient unit RSKD Duren Sawit.

Research Methodology: This study is a type of Quantitative analytic with Cross Sectional. The population is a nurse in Duren Sawit RSKD 2017. The sampling technique used in this research is total sampling 85 respondents. This Analyzed using univariate and bivariate analysis using statistical test Chi Square.

Results: The level of knowledge of nurses well as much as 47 respondents (55.3%) and less knowledgeable many as 38 people (44.7%). Unsafe behavior nurses categorized as low as 52 people (61.2%) and unsafe behavior that high category as many as 33 people (38.8%). The results showed a significant relationship between the knowledge of nurses about health and safety against unsafe behavior RSKD of nurse in Duren Sawit with p-value 0.02 < 0.05.

Tip: Hold a special training related to health and safety at work or through a personal approach to workers in providing information on health and safety at work and the need to refresh the latest sciences to enhance the knowledge to prevent occupational accidents and occupational diseases.
