B. Clarifying the Leadership Myth

1. ***The Management Myth*** – *Management is not leadership*

3. ***The Knowledge Myth*** – *Mental and knowledge superiority does not equate leadership.*

4. ***The Pioneer Myth*** – *the one in the front is not necessary the leader. The leader is the one with the vision that people want to follow*

5. ***The Position Myth*** – *"is not the position that makes the leader, it is the leader that makes the position" – Stanley Huffty*
